What you need in order to enroll your child in Kindergarten:

- Your child must be five (5) years of age on or before October 15, 2015.

- Your child's original birth certificate
  - Your child's up-to-date immunization records
  - You will be asked to provide two (2) proofs of residency. This could be a:
    - current lease agreement
    - current mortgage statement
    - purchase and sales agreement
    - current tax bill
    - current rent receipt
    - current utility bill or bill dates with the past 30 days
